Enroll in and complete MATH 196 (course offered in Fall or Winter quarters)
Complete eight to twelve units of MATH 199H research under supervision of
faculty advisor.
Write an Honors Thesis which will be approved by departmental Honors
Committee and presented orally.

Week 1: Notify research advisor and <a href="mailto:mathadvising@ucsd.edu">mathadvising@ucsd.edu</a> of intent to present. You'll be provided a link to select a timeslot to complete your oral presentation. Be prepared to present for 15 minutes set up, up to 20 minutes followed by a 5-minute Q&A session, and 5 minutes for clean up (30 minutes total)
Week 3: Email math-seminarstaff-g@ucsd.edu with all of the talk details.
Week 4: Submit rough draft of thesis to this form by Friday of week 4 by 11:59 PM. Remind your advisor & UG Honors committee member(s) about the presentation date.
<ul> <li>Week 6 (Day of Presentation):</li> <li>Please bring the following when you give your presentation:</li> <li>A fully charged laptop</li> <li>A copy of your presentation slideshow saved on your device (no internet required)</li> <li>A presentation remote/clicker (if needed)</li> </ul>
Week 9 Submit the final draft of thesis to this form by Friday of week 9 by 11:59 PM.
